1. Name of the Trust:-

Officials of the board:

The board shall have a Chairman, one Vice Chairman, a General Secretary, one Secretary, a Treasurer. We hereby fix and appoint Mr. P. Beeran Haji, K. Abdul Azeez, A K Abdul Salam, K P Abdu Samad, K P Abbass as Chairman, Vice Chairman, General Secretary, Secretary and Treasurer respectively for two years and thereafter the Trustees shall elect the officials from among them and shall not be any taboo for re-electing the retiring office bearers to the post. The term of the officials is two years limit. All lawful activities taken, matters decided and functions performed, duties discharged by the existing officials during the span of their term of office and new election shall be binding on the Board unless otherwise found by the Board as initiated by gross negligence, blatant violation, irresponsibility or malafide.

xvi. FUNCTION OF THE CHAIRMAN:-

The Chairman will preside over the Trustee meetings, supervise the functions of the Trustees and give necessary directions to the proper administration of the Trust and shall represent the Trust in both civil and criminal proceeding and all offices of

xvii. FUNCTIONS OF VICE CHAIRMAN:-

The Vice chairman shall have all the powers of the chairman in his absence and also in his presence when he or the Board of Trustees gives authorities in writing to exercise such powers.

xiii. FUNCTIONS OF THE GENERAL SECRETARY:-

The General Secretary of the Trust shall perform the day to day administrations of the Trust, conduct correspondence on behalf of the Trust, maintain proper accounts of income and expenditure, conveyance, Trust meetings, execute the decision and directions of the Trust and keep all records, papers and documents of the Trust in safe custody but with full right and liberty to any of the Trustees to inspect and copy down them on three days notice. The Secretary can keep in hand cash only up to the limit empowered by the Trustees and the surplus shall be handed over to the treasurer.

xix. FUNCTIONS OF THE SECRETARY:-

The Secretary shall help the General Secretary in all the day to

xxi. OFFICE:-

The Office of the Trust shall be situated at Kaippuram but the Trustees shall have power to shift the location of the office to any other place in Malappuram or Palghat district or open sub offices or offices at such other places as the Trustees deems fit.

xxii. POWERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:-



2) The board may approve an annual budgets for the continuing financial year categorizing the heads of incomes and expenditure on or before last date of every financial year. But the board is at liberty to expand unspend amount of one category to the other according to importance, urgency and circumstances; The financial year being April to March.

3) The board shall have power to acquire, accept or receive any endowments, gifts, grants, aids, alms, either or donations, religious nature, movable or immovable properties made to this Trust by assignments or otherwise by individuals, groups, parties, organizations or associations, funding agencies whether corporated or incorporated, by any government, central or state and all such endowments, gifts, grants, aids, and donations shall be unconditionally caused on and used under the provisions of this Deed.

4) The board shall not have power to sell the properties, if any, of the Trust or any part thereof except in cases of inevitable necessitive and circumstances or for purchasing the more beneficial properties movable or immovable.

5) The board shall not have power to change, alter or mitigate the cause and objectives of the Trust so long as this Trust is in force.



6) The board shall deposit the funds of the Trust excess in such bank or banks as decide by the board. Either of the two from chairman General Secretary and Treasurer can jointly negotiate and operate such accounts by issuing jointly signed cheques or bills.

7) The board shall have power to accept the Trusteeship or management of any other Trust, waqaf, association, organisation or endowment and such Trust, association, Organisation or endowment shall be admitted in concurrence with the provisions of this Deed.

SITTING AND SITTING ALLOWANCES:-

The board shall sit in session at least once in three months and the members are eligible to get allowances as decided by the board from time to time.

NOTICE OF SITTING:-

a) The secretary shall gives minimum seven days notice to the members or the board for to ordinary sitting by in emergency cases the notice period can be reduced to 48 hours.

b) In case the secretary fails to convene the board for its ordinary session, the chairman shall have power to convene the board and hold its session.

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c) If the secretary or the chairman fails to convene the session of the board for a continuous period of six months, 5 members of the board can issue notice to the secretary or chairman demanding to convene the board meeting with 15 days, and noting points to be discussed at the business session or the board meeting, and if the secretary or the chairman does not comply with terms of the said notices, the said 5 members themselves may convene the board meeting within as agenda and decide the matters accordingly, and such meetings shall be deemed to be proper and order.


QUORUM:-

a) The quorum of the board meeting shall be 50% of existing members and all the decisions of the board must be in writes and by majority decisions of the board shall not be questioned by any members of the board except in a court of law but the board shall have power at its discretion to review its own decision.



CASTING VOTE OF CHAIRMAN:-

When the board is in session equally divided in voting, the chairman will have the right of casting vote beside, his ordinary vote and the quality of the matter in dispute will be decided accordingly. This right of casting vote is available to the chairman of the board and not to any other persons authorised by him or presiding over the board in his absence.

ENLARGEMENT OF THE BOARD

According to the circumstances and any necessary occasions, if it is felt by the board the board is empowered and authorize to enlarge/expand the strength authorized by nominating as many honest members from outside as thinks fit by 2/3rd majority of the members shall not exceed 50 in any circumstances.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION:-

Any Trustee or Trustees whose acts, omissions or behavior are found detrimental to the interest of the Trust may be suspended or dismissed by the board by a resolution approved by 2/3rd majority of the board in case of no reply to the show cause notice given to such Trustee or Trustees or in the case of reply which is unsatisfactory.

RESIGNATION:-

The Trust is to be governed by the provisions of the Indian Trust act 1882.




